

I first met Michael Echaniz shortly after he began his bachelor's degree at the California Jazz Conservatory back in 2014. Michael studied a number of different subjects with me, including taking several semesters of a course where he and fellow CJC student, Dillon Vado, met with me weekly to play a wide array of music as a trio. In those semesters, we focused on the music of Bud Powell, Chick Corea, and compositions by contemporary jazz artists such as Brad Mehldau, Edward Simon, and Tigran Hamasyan. Michael stood out to me at the CJC right away because it was very apparent that he was an extremely talented musician who was completely dedicated to becoming a world-class artist. I have enormous respect for him, because not only is he unafraid of hard work, but he also thrives on it.

When Michael began bringing in his own compositions to the trio, we started to find our own original voice as a group. His compositions are extremely detailed, with a great deal of complexity and depth. The process of working out the complex rhythmic structures in his music, along with the high level of specificity in each part, required a great deal of work for all of us individually, as well as a group. All the technical aspects of the music aside, I was captivated by Michael's unique musical vision, and I wanted to produce this project for him to help him bring his debut album to fruition. 
